- c. **Jude 24** him that is able to keep you from falling
- d. 1 John 1.9-10 if we say we have not sinned
- e. **Rev 12.10-11** the accuser of our brethren

2. Harmless

- a. **Phil 3.15-19** who mind earthly things
- b. Matt 23.27-28 woe unto you pharisees
- c. 1 Pet 2.15-16 that with well doing ye may put to silence
- d. 3 John 9-10 prating against us with malicious words

- b. Acts 8.4 went everywhere preaching the word

Phil 2.15-16

1. Blameless

- Rom 3.23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- **Rom 12..1-2** I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. 2: And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- **Jude 24** Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,
- **1 John 1.9-10** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 10: If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.
- **Rev 12.10-11** And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. 11: And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

2. Harmless

- **Phil 3.15-17** Let us therefore, as many as be perfect, be thus minded: and if in any thing ye be otherwise minded, God shall reveal even this unto you. 16: Nevertheless, whereto we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us mind the same thing. 17: Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.
- Matt 23.27-28 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead men's bones, and of all uncleanness. 28: Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within ye are full of hypocrisy and iniquity.
- **1 Pet 2.15-16** For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: 16: As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke of maliciousness, but as the servants of God.

Phil 2.15-16

3 John 9-10 - I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not. 10: Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth them out of the church.

3. The Result

- **Phil 2.16** Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.
- Acts 8.4 Therefore they that were scattered abroad went every where preaching the word.
- Matt 5.16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
