Job 25.1-6

1. The dominion of God

Job 25.2 - Dominion and fear are with him, he maketh peace in his high places.

Psm 18.6-7 - In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried unto my God: he heard my voice out of his temple, and my cry came before him, even into his ears. 7: Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations also of the hills moved and were shaken, because he was wroth.

Psm 29.3-4 - The voice of the LORD is upon the waters: the God of glory thundereth: the LORD is upon many waters. 4: The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty.

Psm 107.40-42 - He poureth contempt upon princes, and causeth them to wander in the wilderness, where there is no way. 41: Yet setteth he the poor on high from affliction, and maketh him families like a flock. 42: The righteous shall see it, and rejoice: and all iniquity shall stop her mouth.

Joel 2.30-32 - And I will shew wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke. 31: The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the LORD come. 32: And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call.

Jer 23.24 - Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith the LORD. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the LORD.

Job 25.3 - Is there any number of his armies? and upon whom doth not his light arise?

Matt 5.45 - That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.

Psm 68.35 - O God, thou art terrible out of thy holy places: the God of Israel is he that giveth strength and power unto his people. Blessed be God.

Psm 76.11-12 - Vow, and pay unto the LORD your God: let all that be round about him bring presents unto him that ought to be feared. 12: He shall cut off the spirit of princes: he is terrible to the kings of the earth.

Heb 10.31 - It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

3. Power of peace

Job 25.2 - Dominion and fear are with him, he maketh peace in his high places.

Psm 29.11 - The LORD will give strength unto his people; the LORD will bless his people with peace.

Psm 85.8-11 - I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his saints: but let them not turn again to folly. 9: Surely his salvation is nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land. 10: Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other 11: Truth shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down from heaven.

Isa 9.6 - For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

Eph 2.14-15 - For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us; 15: Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;

4. A question of justification

Job 25.4 - How then can man be justified with God? or how can he be clean that is born of a woman?

Psm 143.1-2 - Hear my prayer, O LORD, give ear to my supplications: in thy faithfulness answer me, and in thy righteousness. 2: And enter not into judgment with thy servant: for in thy sight shall no man living be justified.

Job 25.5 - Behold even to the moon, and it shineth not; yea, the stars are not pure in his sight.

2 Pet 2.4 - For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

Rom 5.1 - Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

Rom 5.9 - Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

Job 25.6 - How much less man, that is a worm? and the son of man, which is a worm?

1 Cor 6.11 - And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.
