# 1. The healing at Bethesda

- **John 5.4-5** For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had. 5: And a certain man was there, which had an infirmity thirty and eight years.
- **John 5.8-9** Jesus saith unto him, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk. 9: And immediately the man was made whole, and took up his bed, and walked: and on the same day was the sabbath.
- **John 5.10** The Jews therefore said unto him that was cured, It is the sabbath day: it is not lawful for thee to carry thy bed.
- **John 5.16** And therefore did the Jews persecute Jesus, and sought to slay him, because he had done these things on the sabbath day.

#### 2. Intent

- **John 5.19** Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise
- **John 5.30** I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.
- **John 5.33** Ye sent unto John, and he bare witness unto the truth.
- **John 5.35** He was a burning and a shining light:
- **Mal 4.5-6** Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD: 6: And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.
- **Matt 11.13-14** For all the prophets and the law prophesied until John. 14: And if ye will receive it, this is Elias, which was for to come.
- **John 5.35** and ye were willing for a season to rejoice in his light

## 3. Witness

#### John 5.33-42

- **John 5.36** But I have greater witness than that of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.
- **John 5.31-32** If I bear witness of myself, my witness is not true. 32: There is another that beareth witness of me; and I know that the witness which he witnesseth of me is true.
- **John 5.36** for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.
- **Heb 2.3-4** How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him; 4: God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will?
- **1 John 5.6** This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth.
- **John 12.48** He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.
- **John 14.26** But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.
- **2 Pet 1.16** For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of his majesty.
- **2 Pet 1.21** For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.

#### 4. Result

- **John 5.34** But I receive not testimony from man: but these things I say, that ye might be saved.
- **John 5.39** Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me.
- **John 5.47** But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?
- **John 5.24** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that

sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.
