## The Great Example

Phil 2.5-11

#### 1. What mind

- **Lk 13.3** I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.
- **Rom 12.2** And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- **Acts 2.40** And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation.
- **2 Tim 2.25-26** In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; 26: And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.
- **2 Cor 4.4** In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.the god of this world blinds

#### 2. What prohibits

- 1 Cor 1.18 For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.
- **Acts 17.18** Then certain philosophers of the Epicureans, and of the Stoicks, encountered him. And some said, What will this babbler say? other some, He seemeth to be a setter forth of strange gods: because he preached unto them Jesus, and the resurrection.
- Lk 16.8-... for the children of this world are in their generation wiser than the children of light.
- **1 Cor 1.21** For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.

### 3. The great Example

- **Phil 2.6** Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:
- **Col 1.16** For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

Phil 2.5-11

- **Eph 1.10** That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:
- **Phil 2.7** But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:
- **John 9.4** I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.
- **Phil 2.8** And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.
- **Rev 2.10** ... be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.
- **Phil 2.9-11** Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: 10: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; 11: And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
