## Historical Judgment

Job 22.10-13

### 1. Unprofitable servant

**Job 22.2** - Can a man be profitable unto God, as he that is wise may be profitable unto himself?

**2 Cor 4.7** - But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.

**Job 22.3** - Is it any pleasure to the Almighty, that thou art righteous? or is it gain to him that thou makest thy ways perfect?

**Job 22.4** - Will he reprove thee for fear of thee? will he enter with thee into judgment?

**Job 21.15** - What is the Almighty, that we should serve him? and what profit should we have, if we pray unto him?

### 2. Unfounded judgment

**Job 22.5** - Is not thy wickedness great? and thine iniquities infinite?

**Job 22.6-9** - For thou hast taken a pledge from thy brother for nought, and stripped the naked of their clothing. 7: Thou hast not given water to the weary to drink, and thou hast withholden bread from the hungry. 8: But as for the mighty man, he had the earth; and the honourable man dwelt in it. 9: Thou has sent widows away empty, and the arms of the fatherless have been broken.

**Rom 14.10** - But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ.

**Job 22.10-11** - Therefore snares are round about thee, and sudden fear troubleth thee; 11: Or darkness, that thou canst not see; and abundance of waters cover thee.

**Psm 69.1-3** - Save me, O God; for the waters are come in unto my soul. 2: I sink in deep mire, where there is no standing: I am come into deep waters, where the floods overflow me. 3: I am weary of my crying: my throat is dried: mine eyes fail while I wait for my God.

**Rom 14.13** - Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother's way.

Job 22.10-13

**1 Cor 4.5** - Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God.

**Job 22.15-16** - Hast thou marked the old way which wicked men have trodden? 16: Which were cut down out of time, whose foundation was overflown with a flood:

### 3. How does God know

**Job 22.12-14** - Is not God in the height of heaven? and behold the height of the stars, how high they are! 13: And thou sayest, How doth God know? can he judge through the dark cloud? 14: Thick clouds are a covering to him, that he seeth not; and he walketh in the circuit of heaven.

**Psm 104.1-3** - Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honour and majesty. 2: Who coverest thyself with light as with a garment: who stretchest out the heavens like a curtain: 3: Who layeth the beams of his chambers in the waters: who maketh the clouds his chariot: who walketh upon the wings of the wind:

**Psm 139.7-10** - Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence? 8: If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there. 9: If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea; 10: Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me.

**2 Chron 16.9** - For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him.

**Psm 11.4** - The LORD is in his holy temple, the LORD's throne is in heaven: his eyes behold, his eyelids try, the children of men.

**Isa 59.1-2** - Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: 2: But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.
