1. Let this mind be in you ....

**Phil 2.5** - Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

Col 3.16 - Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom

**Lk 8.12-14** - Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. 13: They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away. 14: And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection.

Jas 1.8 - A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.

**Matt 23.2-3** - The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat: 3: All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do; but do not ye after their works: for they say, and do not.

**Jas 3.1** - My brethren, be not many masters, knowing that we shall receive the greater condemnation.

**Gal 6.1-2** - Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. 2: Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

Lk 9.46 - Then there arose a reasoning among them, which of them should be greatest.

Matt 23.11 - But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant.

**Matt 18.1** - At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?

Matt 18.4 - Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

**Matt 20.20-21** - Then came to him the mother of Zebedee's children with her sons, worshipping him, and desiring a certain thing of him. 21: And he said unto her, What wilt thou? She saith unto him, Grant that these my two sons may sit, the one on thy right hand, and the other on the left, in thy kingdom.

Lk 22.31-32 - Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as

wheat: 32: But I have prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.

**Heb 11.6** - But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

**2 Pet 1.19** - We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

**1 John 4.16-17** - And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. 17: Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

John 14.15 - If ye love me, keep my commandments.
