- **Job 32.2** Then was kindled the wrath of Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite, of the kindred of Ram: against Job was his wrath kindled, because he justified himself rather than God.
- **Job 32.3** Also against his three friends was his wrath kindled, because they had found no answer, and yet had condemned Job.
- **Job 32.3** they had found no answer, and yet had condemned Job.
- **Job 32.4,6** Now Elihu had waited till Job had spoken, because they were elder than he.... I am young, and ye are very old; wherefore I was afraid, and durst not shew you mine opinion.
- **Job 32.21-22** Let me not, I pray you, accept any man's person, neither let me give flattering titles unto man. 22: For I know not to give flattering titles; in so doing my maker would soon take me away.
- **Job 33.3** My words shall be of the uprightness of my heart: and my lips shall utter knowledge clearly.
- **Job 33.4,6** The Spirit of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life....Behold, I am according to thy wish in God's stead: I also am formed out of the clay.
- **Job 32.14** Now he hath not directed his words against me: neither will I answer him with your speeches.
- **Job 32.12** Yea, I attended unto you, and, behold, there was none of you that convinced Job, or that answered his words
- **Job 33.7** Behold, my terror shall not make thee afraid, neither shall my hand be heavy upon thee.
- **Job 33.11-12** He putteth my feet in the stocks, he marketh all my paths. 12: Behold, in this thou art not just: I will answer thee, that God is greater than man.

### Job 32.1-6

- **1 Pet 5.5** Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.
- **Matt 5.37** But let your communication be, Yea, yea; Nay, nay: for whatsoever is more than these cometh of evil
- **Col 4.6** Let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.
- **1 Thess 5.15** See that none render evil for evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all men.
- **2 Cor 5.11** Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences.
- **Gal 6.1** Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
