1 Cor 13.5-7

1. Actions

- **1 Cor 13.5** Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil;
- **Rom 12.10**: Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another:
- **Rom 14.19** 19: Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another.
- **Prov:25:28**: He that hath no rule over his own spirit is like a city that is broken down, and without walls.
- **Eph 4.26-27** 26: Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath: 27: Neither give place to the devil.
- **Heb:12:14**: Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:
- **Phil 4.7** 7: And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

2. True Rejoicing

- 1 Cor 13.6 6: Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth;
- **Rom 12.2**: And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- **Col:3:12**: Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;
- **Matt 4.4**: But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

2 Pet 1.5-9 - 5: And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; 6: And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; 7: And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity. 8: For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9: But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

Heb 12.13-15 - 13: And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed. 14: Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: 15: Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled;

Col:3:24: Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ.
