Phil 2.25-30

#### 1. The illness of Epaphroditus

- **Phil 4.18** But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God.
- **Phil 2.25** Yet I supposed it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, and companion in labour, and fellowsoldier, but your messenger, and he that ministered to my wants.
- **Phil 2.27** For indeed he was sick nigh unto death: but God had mercy on him; and not on him only, but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow.

#### 2. Witness

- **John 17.8** For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.
- **John 16.12-13** I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. 13: Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.
- Acts 2.42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.
- **Heb 2.3-4** How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him; 4: God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will?
- **2 Tim 3.16** All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:
- **2 Peter 1.3** According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

**Acts 3.6** - Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.

## Phil 2.25-30

- **Acts 3.11** And as the lame man which was healed held Peter and John, all the people ran together unto them in the porch that is called Solomon's, greatly wondering.
- Acts 5.12 And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch.
- Acts 5.14 And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.)
- **Acts 8.5-6** Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them. 6: And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.
- Acts 8.12 But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.
- **Acts 9.33-34** And there he found a certain man named Aeneas, which had kept his bed eight years, and was sick of the palsy. 34: And Peter said unto him, Aeneas, Jesus Christ maketh thee whole: arise, and make thy bed. And he arose immediately.
- Acts 9.35 And all that dwelt at Lydda and Saron saw him, and turned to the Lord.

#### 4. Facts

- 1 Cor 12.12 For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.
- **Ephesians 4.11-12** And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; 12: For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:
- **1 Cor 12.4-6** Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. 5: And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. 6: And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.
- 1 Cor 12.31 But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way.
- **1 Cor 13.9-10** For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. 10: But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away.
- **Jas 5.14-15** Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:
