Isaiah 43.9-12

2. Declared Most High

- **Isa 43.10** Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me.
- **Psm 47.2** For the LORD most high is terrible; he is a great King over all the earth.
- **Psm 83.18** hat men may know that thou, whose name alone is JEHOVAH, art the most high over all the earth.
- **1 Cor 15.27** For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.

3. Dwelling

- **1 Tim 6.16** Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen.
- **Acts 17.24** God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands;
- **Isa 40.21-22** Have ye not known? have ye not heard? hath it not been told you from the beginning? have ye not understood from the foundations of the earth? 22: It is he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:
- **1 Kings 8.27** But will God indeed dwell on the earth? behold, the heaven and heaven of heavens cannot contain thee; how much less this house that I have builded?

- **Deut 4.15-16** Take ye therefore good heed unto yourselves; for ye saw no manner of similitude on the day that the LORD spake unto you in Horeb out of the midst of the fire: 16: Lest ye corrupt yourselves, and make you a graven image, the similitude of any figure, the likeness of male or female,
- **Ex 33.18-20** And he said, I beseech thee, shew me thy glory. 19: And he said, I will make all my goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy. 20: And he said, Thou canst not see my face: for there shall no man see me, and live.

Isaiah 43.9-12

Rom 1.23 - And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.

5. Purity of God

- **Jas 1.13-14** Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: 14: But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.
- **Psm 11.7** For the righteous LORD loveth righteousness; his countenance doth behold the upright.
- **Psm 33.4-5** For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in truth. 5: He loveth righteousness and judgment: the earth is full of the goodness of the LORD.
- **Psm 36.6** hy righteousness is like the great mountains; thy judgments are a great deep: O LORD, thou preservest man and beast.

- **Eph 1.15-18** Wherefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints.
- 16: Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers; 17: That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: 18: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints.
- **2 Cor 1.3** Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort;
- **Jas 1.17** Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.
