Job 20.1-7

1. I just can't hold back anymore

- **Job 20.2** Therefore do my thoughts cause me to answer, and for this I make haste.
- **Job 20.3** I have heard the check of my reproach, and the spirit of my understanding causeth me to answer.
- Matt 15.9 But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.
- **John 7.24** Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.

2. Appraisal of evil

- **Job 20.8** He shall fly away as a dream, and shall not be found: yea, he shall be chased away as a vision of the night.
- **Psm 73.19-20** How are they brought into desolation, as in a moment! they are utterly consumed with terrors. 20: As a dream when one awaketh; so, O Lord, when thou awakest, thou shalt despise their image.
- **Job 20.9-10** The eye also which saw him shall see him no more; neither shall his place any more behold him. 10: His children shall seek to please the poor, and his hands shall restore their goods.
- **Job 20.27** The heaven shall reveal his iniquity; and the earth shall rise up against him.

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- **Psm 73.12** Behold, these are the ungodly, who prosper in the world; they increase in riches.
- **Job 21.8-9** Their seed is established in their sight with them, and their offspring before their eyes. 9: Their houses are safe from fear, neither is the rod of God upon them.
- Psm 73.5 They are not in trouble as other men; neither are they plagued like other men.

5. Contrast in attitude

- **Job 21.17** How oft is the candle of the wicked put out! and how oft cometh their destruction upon them! God distributeth sorrows in his anger.
- **Psm 73.17-18** Until I went into the sanctuary of God; then understood I their end. 18: Surely thou didst set them in slippery places: thou castedst them down into destruction.
- **Job 21.18** They are as stubble before the wind, and as chaff that the storm carrieth away.
- **Psm 1.4-6** The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away. 5: Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. 6: For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.
- **Job 21.22** Shall any teach God knowledge? seeing he judgeth those that are high.
- **Eccl 8.12-13** Though a sinner do evil an hundred times, and his days be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that fear God, which fear before him: 13: But it shall not be well with the wicked, neither shall he prolong his days, which are as a shadow; because he feareth not before God.
- **Job 21.23-25** One dieth in his full strength, being wholly at ease and quiet. 24: His breasts are full of milk, and his bones are moistened with marrow. 25: And another dieth in the bitterness of his soul, and never eateth with pleasure.
- **Job 21.26** -They shall lie down alike in the dust, and the worms shall cover them.
- **Eccl 2.14-15** The wise man's eyes are in his head; but the fool walketh in darkness: and I myself perceived also that one event happeneth to them all. 15: Then said I in my heart, As it happeneth to the fool, so it happeneth even to me; and why was I then more wise? Then I said in my heart, that this also is vanity.
- Eccl 3.18-19 I said in mine heart concerning the estate of the sons of men, that God might

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manifest them, and that they might see that they themselves are beasts. 19: For that which befalleth the sons of men befalleth beasts; even one thing befalleth them: as the one dieth, so dieth the other; yea, they have all one breath; so that a man hath no preeminence above a beast: for all is vanity.
