### 2. Power beyond comprehension

#### a. God's presence and vision

1. **Job 26.6** - hell is naked before him
2. **Psm 139.7-8** - Whither shall I go from thy spirit
3. **Prov 15.11** - Hell and destruction are before the LORD
4. **Jonah 2.1-2** - out of the belly of hell cried I

#### b. God's power to create

1. **Job 26.7** - stretcheth out the North over empty place
2. **Psm 104.2** - stretchest out the heavens like a curtain
3. **Isa 40.21-22** - It is he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth

#### c. God's power over the elements

1. **Job 26.8** - bindeth up the waters in thick clouds
2. **Prov 30.4** - who hath gathered the wind in his fists
3. **Isa 40.12** - Who hath measured the waters in the hollow of his hand

#### d. God's concealment

1. **Job 26.9** - holdeth back the face of his throne
2. **Psm 104.3** - Who layeth the beams of his chambers in the waters

**Job 26.2** - How hast thou helped him that is without power? how savest thou the arm that hath no strength?

**Job 26.3** - How hast thou counselled him that hath no wisdom? and how hast thou plentifully declared the thing as it is?

**Job 26.4** - To whom hast thou uttered words? and whose spirit came from thee?

### 2. Power beyond comprehension

#### a. God's presence and vision

**Job 26.6** - Hell is naked before him, and destruction hath no covering.

**Psm 139.7-8** - Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?  
8: If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there.

**Prov 15.11** - Hell and destruction are before the LORD: how much more then the hearts of the children of men?

**Jonah 2.1-2** - Then Jonah prayed unto the LORD his God out of the fish's belly, 2: And said, I cried by reason of mine affliction unto the LORD, and he heard me; out of the belly of hell cried I, and thou heardest my voice.

#### b. God's power to create

**Job 26.7** - He stretcheth out the north over the empty place, and hangeth the earth upon nothing.

**Psm 104.2** - Who coverest thyself with light as with a garment: who stretchest out the heavens like a curtain:

**Isa 40.21-22** - Have ye not known? have ye not heard? hath it not been told you from the beginning? have ye not understood from the foundations of the earth? 22: It is he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:

Job 26.5-9

(Read: Job 26.1-4)

**Job 26.8** - He bindeth up the waters in his thick clouds; and the cloud is not rent under them.

**Prov 30.4** - Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou canst tell?

**Isa 40.12** - Who hath measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, and meted out heaven with the span, and comprehended the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales, and the hills in a balance?

### **d. God's concealment**

**Job 26.9** - He holdeth back the face of his throne, and spreadeth his cloud upon it.

**Psm 104.3** - Who layeth the beams of his chambers in the waters: who maketh the clouds his chariot: who walketh upon the wings of the wind:

**Eccl 3.11** - He hath made every thing beautiful in his time: also he hath set the world in their heart, so that no man can find out the work that God maketh from the beginning to the end.
