**Job 19.1-7**

### **1. Isolation & depression**

**Job 19.2** - How long will ye vex my soul, and break me in pieces with words?

**Job 19.3** - hese ten times have ye reproached me: ye are not ashamed that ye make yourselves strange to me.

**Job 19.4** - And be it indeed that I have erred, mine error remaineth with myself.

**Job 19.6** - Know now that God hath overthrown me, and hath compassed me with his net.

### **2. Unheard cry**

**Job 19.7** - Behold, I cry out of wrong, but I am not heard: I cry aloud, but there is no judgment.

**Rev 16.9-10** - And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: 10: And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

**Lk 18.7** - And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?

**Rom 11.3-5** - Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life. 4: But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal. 5: Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace.

**Rom 12.19** - Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

### **3. Distorted perception**

**Job 19.8** - He hath fenced up my way that I cannot pass, and he hath set darkness in my paths.

**2 Cor 12.9** - And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

**Heb 11.34** - Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were

made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.

**Job 19.10** - He hath destroyed me on every side, and I am gone: and mine hope hath he removed like a tree.

**Heb 10.34** - For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an enduring substance.

**2 Cor 6.10** - As sorrowful, yet alway rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things.

**Job 19.11** - He hath also kindled his wrath against me, and he counteth me unto him as one of his enemies.

**Eph 6.16** - Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

**1 Pet 4.12** - Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you:

**Job 19.17** - My breath is strange to my wife, though I intreated for the children's sake of mine own body.

**Rom 8.35-36** - Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36: As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.

**2 Cor 6.4-9** - But in all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses, 5: In stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labours, in watchings, in fastings; 6: By pureness, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Ghost, by love unfeigned, 7: By the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armour of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, 8: By honour and dishonour, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and yet true; 9: As unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and, behold, we live; as chastened, and not killed;

**Job 19.25-27** - For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth: 26: And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God: 27: Whom I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold, and not another; though my reins be consumed within me.
