- a. **Gen 49.10** - the sceptre shall not depart from Judah ... nor lawgiver ... till Shiloh come
- b. **Psm 45.6-7** - thy throne is forever
- c. **2 Sam 7.16** - kingdom established forever
- d. **Psm 72.1-7** - length of his reign
- e. **Rom 15.12** - reign over Gentiles
- f. **1 Cor 15.25** - reign until all enemies under his feet
- g. **Acts 2.34-36** - sit thou upon my right hand

4. Deliverance

- a. **Ex 12.5-7** - passover lamb and blood
- b. **Ex 12.12-13** - I will pass over you - blood as a token
- c. **1 Cor 5.7** - Christ our passover is sacrificed for us
- d. **2 cor 1.10-11** - delivered us from so great a death \
- e. **Gal 1.4** - that he might deliver us from this present evil world
- f. **1 Thess 1.10** - delivered us from the wrath to come

2. Firstborn

Gen 22.12 - And he said, Lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou any thing unto him: for now I know that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son from me.

Ex 11.5 - And all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sitteth upon his throne, even unto the firstborn of the maidservant that is behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts.

Ex 13.2 - Sanctify unto me all the firstborn, whatsoever openeth the womb among the children of Israel, both of man and of beast: it is mine.

Ex 22.29 - Thou shalt not delay to offer the first of thy ripe fruits, and of thy liquors: the firstborn of thy sons shalt thou give unto me.

Psm 89.27-29 - Also I will make him my firstborn, higher than the kings of the earth. 28: My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and my covenant shall stand fast with him. 29: His seed also will I make to endure for ever, and his throne as the days of heaven.

Col 1.15 - Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:

Col 1.18 - And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.

3. King & Lawgiver

Gen 49.10 - The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.

Psm 45.6-7 - Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom is a right sceptre. 7: Thou lovest righteousness, and hatest wickedness: therefore God, thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

2 Sam 7.16 - And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established for ever.

Psm 72.1-7 - Give the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son. 2: He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment. 3: The mountains shall bring peace to the people, and the little hills, by righteousness. 4: He shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor. 5: They shall fear thee as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations. 6: He shall

come down like rain upon the mown grass: as showers that water the earth. 7: In his days shall the righteous flourish; and abundance of peace so long as the moon endureth.

Rom 15.12 - And again, Esaias saith, There shall be a root of Jesse, and he that shall rise to reign over the Gentiles; in him shall the Gentiles trust.

1 Cor 15.25 -For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.

Acts 2.34-36 - For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, 35: Until I make thy foes thy footstool. 36: Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.

4. Deliverance

Ex 12.5-7 - Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats: 6: And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening. 7: And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it.

Ex 12.12-13 - For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD. 13: And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt.

1 Cor 5.7 - Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

2 cor 1.10-11 - Who delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver: in whom we trust that he will yet deliver us; 11: Ye also helping together by prayer for us, that for the gift bestowed upon us by the means of many persons thanks may be given by many on our behalf.

Gal 1.4 - Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:

1 Thess 1.10 - And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come.
