2. Fellowship (v.1-2)

- **Rom 12.10** Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another;
- **John 15.13** Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.
- **John 15.14-15** 14: Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you.
- **John 20.29** Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.
- **Eph 4..13** Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

3. Confidence (v.3)

- **Heb 10.35** Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward.
- **John 14.1-4** Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. 2: In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3: And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. 4: And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.
- **1 Cor 3.13-14** Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. 14: If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward.
- **2 Tim 4.7-8** I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: 8: Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.
- Gal 6.9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

4. Encouragement (v.4-5)

- **Rom 5.1-3** Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: 2: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. 3: And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience;
- 1 Thess 5.16-17 Rejoice evermore . Pray without ceasing
- 2 Thess 3.3 But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil.
- 1 Cor 16.13 Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong.
- **1 Pet 4.4** Wherein they think it strange that ye run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you:

5. Peace (v.6-7)

- **1 Tim 2.1-2** I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2: For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- **Rom 14.19** Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another.
- **Rev 20.12** And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.
- **Col 3.15** And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.
