Strife & Vainglory

Phil 2.1-4

1. Consolation in Christ

- **Phil 2.1** If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies
- **Mal 3.14** Ye have said, It is vain to serve God: and what profit is it that we have kept his ordinance, and that we have walked mournfully before the LORD of hosts?
- 1 Cor 15.16-20 For if the dead rise not, then is not Christ raised: 17: And if Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins. 18: Then they also which are fallen asleep in Christ are perished. 19: If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable. 20: But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept.
- **John 3.36** He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.
- **Rom 5.9** Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

2. Likemindedness

- **Phil 2.2** Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.
- **Psm 133.1** Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!
- **John 17.20-21** Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; 21: That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

3. Strife & Vainglory

- **Phil 2.3-4** Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. 4: Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.
- **Rom 12.10** Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another;

Strife & Vainglory

Phil 2.1-4

- **1 Jhn 3.11-12** For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another. 12: Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother. And wherefore slew he him? Because his own works were evil, and his brother's righteous.
- Gal 5.26 Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.
- **James 3.16** For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.
- **Eph 4.4-6** -There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; 5: One Lord, one faith, one baptism, 6: One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.
